
### A REPORT ON

# TEACHERS' FEEDBACK ON THE SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTION 2021-22


#### HIGHLIGHTS

- ➤ **Response:** In the feedback on the syllabus and its transaction at the institution a total of 51 teachers registered their feedback on the following aspects of syllabus and its transaction.
- ➤ Relevance of syllabus: A very high percentage of teachers (60.8 %) agreed with the relevance of the syllabus to the modern nature of the subject. Another, 31.4 percentage of teachers strongly agreed with content of the syllabus. In other words, a total of 92.2 percent of teachers have positive opinion about the relevance of the content of the syllabus curriculum (Full statistics below).
- 1. The courses/syllabi of the subject taught in the semesters are relevant to modern nature of the subject -



- Size of the syllabus: About the size of the syllabus in terms of workload on students 62.7 percent teachers responded as "good" followed by "very good" and "excellent" with a figure of 23.5 and 13.7 percent respectively. (Full statistics below).

- Freedom in the college to adopt new techniques/strategies of teaching such as group discussion, seminar presentations and learners' participation: 47. 1 percent agreed to the question of full freedom in the college to adopt new techniques/strategies of teaching, followed by strongly agree with 37.3 percent response. So a high percentage (84.4 %) of response was positive about the full freedom being provided by the institution.
- 3. There is full freedom in the college to adopt new techniques/strategies of teaching such as group discussions, seminar presentations and learners' participation 51 responses




➤ Assessment tests and examination are conducted well in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus:

96.1 percent of the responses had positive opinion (Strongly agree – 56.9 % and Agree – 39.2 %) about assessment tests and examination being conducted well in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus.



Prescribed reference books/journals are available in the library in sufficient numbers: 45 percent of the respondents agreed with the statement. However, a high percentage of respondents disagreed (27.5 %) and neither agreed nor disagreed (23.5 %) in order of rank. So, this aspect needs to be looked in.


5. The prescribed reference books/journals are available in the library in sufficient numbers - 51 responses



# ➤ Interaction and guidance of the students outside the class:


76.5 percent of the respondents mentioned that they always interact and offers guidance to the students outside the class followed by 19.6 percent who mentioned they do it sometimes.

6. Interaction and guidance of the students outside the class - 51 responses




➤ ICT facilities in the college are adequate and satisfactory: 33.3 percent of the respondents agreed to ICT facilities in the college being adequate and satisfactory. However, the cumulative percentage of disagree and agree in order of rank is 29.4 and 21.6 percent respectively. This aspect needs to be looked in with greater attention.

7. ICT facilities in the college are adequate and satisfactory - 51 responses




- > Study materials and other reference resources are provided to students: About 86.3 percent of the respondents mentioned that they provide study materials and other reference resources to students.

➤ E-resources are made available: About 71 percent of the respondents mentionded that e-resources are made available by them but only sometimes. Only 27.5 percent of the respondents mentioned they always provide e-resources. This aspect also needs to be paid attention.


## 9. E-resources are made available -

Tutorial classes for weak students are taken: About 71 percent of the respondents mentioned that they provide tutorial classes for weak students on demand, which is a very positive approach. 17.6 percent mentioned they take 1 to 2 classes in a week and another 9.8 percent mentioned they take classes more than two classes in a week. This aspect also needs to be looked in and tutorial classes for weak students offered regularly every week will be desirable.
