Steps Taken to Improve the Slow Learners English Department

In English Department slow learners and advanced learners are identified when the students come to attend classes in the 1st semester.

Slow Learners students are given extra care as they are unable to cope up with the advanced learners. We try to identify slow learners based on their performance and response in their class and in their Internal exam.

Thus following steps are taken to improve their quality:-

- (1) Classes are taken once a week on every Friday of each month.
- (2) Special attention is paid to develop their vocabulary and speaking skill in English.
- (3) Summary of their prescribed syllabus are taught and questions and answers are discussed.
- (4) Materials on each topic are given.
- (5) Motivating words are delivered to encourage the students.
- (6) Try to engage them in group activity to boost interactive learning and confidence among them.
- (7) Help them in note making and memorizing.
- (8) Re-exams are conducted to make them score good marks.
