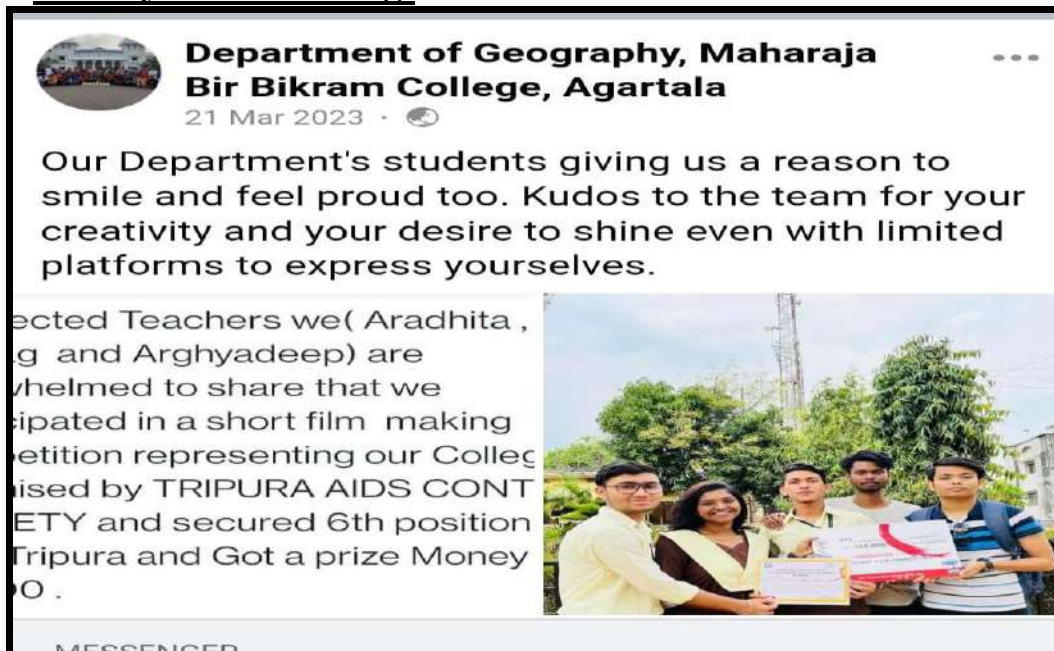

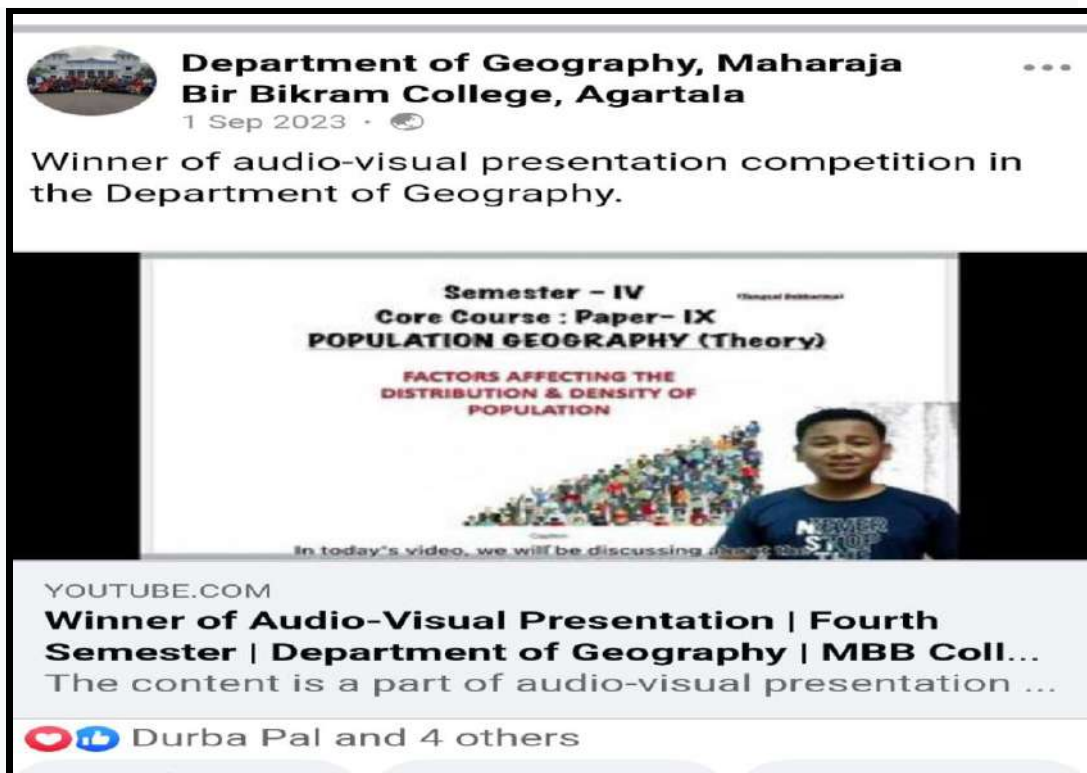


Pic. 25. Learning through active participation: Department of Geography encourages its students to actively participate in learning sessions.

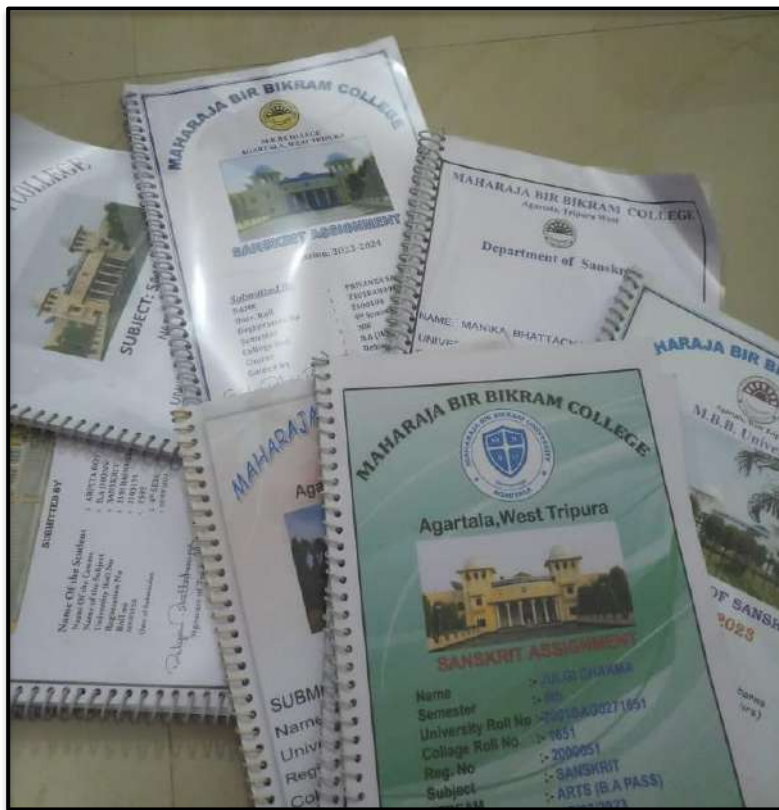
