s.no	Issues Raised by students
1	There are computer-based practical's but there is only one working computer in the department. Students need more computers
2	The central library does not have books like newspaper, paper, e-journals, current affair, general knowledge
3	Glass tables are not sufficient for tracing. The glasses of some glass tables are broken and there is a possibility of students getting injured while working on them
4	The maps in the department are very old and torn which makes it difficult to do practicals.
5	There are one or two climatological instruments and that too is not working properly due to which students face problem in taking daily readings.
6	There is no canteen, drinking water and toilet facilities for the students in the college.

s.no	Action Taken by Mentor /Department
1	Presently the department has one computer and one printer. The department has requisitioned/demanded more computers from the college authority for practical classes.
2	The department has its own mini library where teachers keep their personal books for students. Mentors keep providing books and study materials.
3	Glass table requisition will be given.
4	Old maps are paper maps which get spoiled quickly and colors also fade away. Therefore, the department will order laminated maps.
5	The order of climatological instrument has been given to the vendor. These instruments are very delicate and can get damaged if not handled properly. Therefore, students are also instructed to handle these instruments with care.
6	The department understands the plight of its students and makes every possible effort. The department has a jar of drinking water in every semester which is refilled by Geography students Forum (GSF).

Department organizes Mentor -Mentee meet in the beginning and end of each session. Apart from this, the mentor also meets regularly with their mentees to keep track of their study-progress, to know their problems related to academic as well as personal (if any).

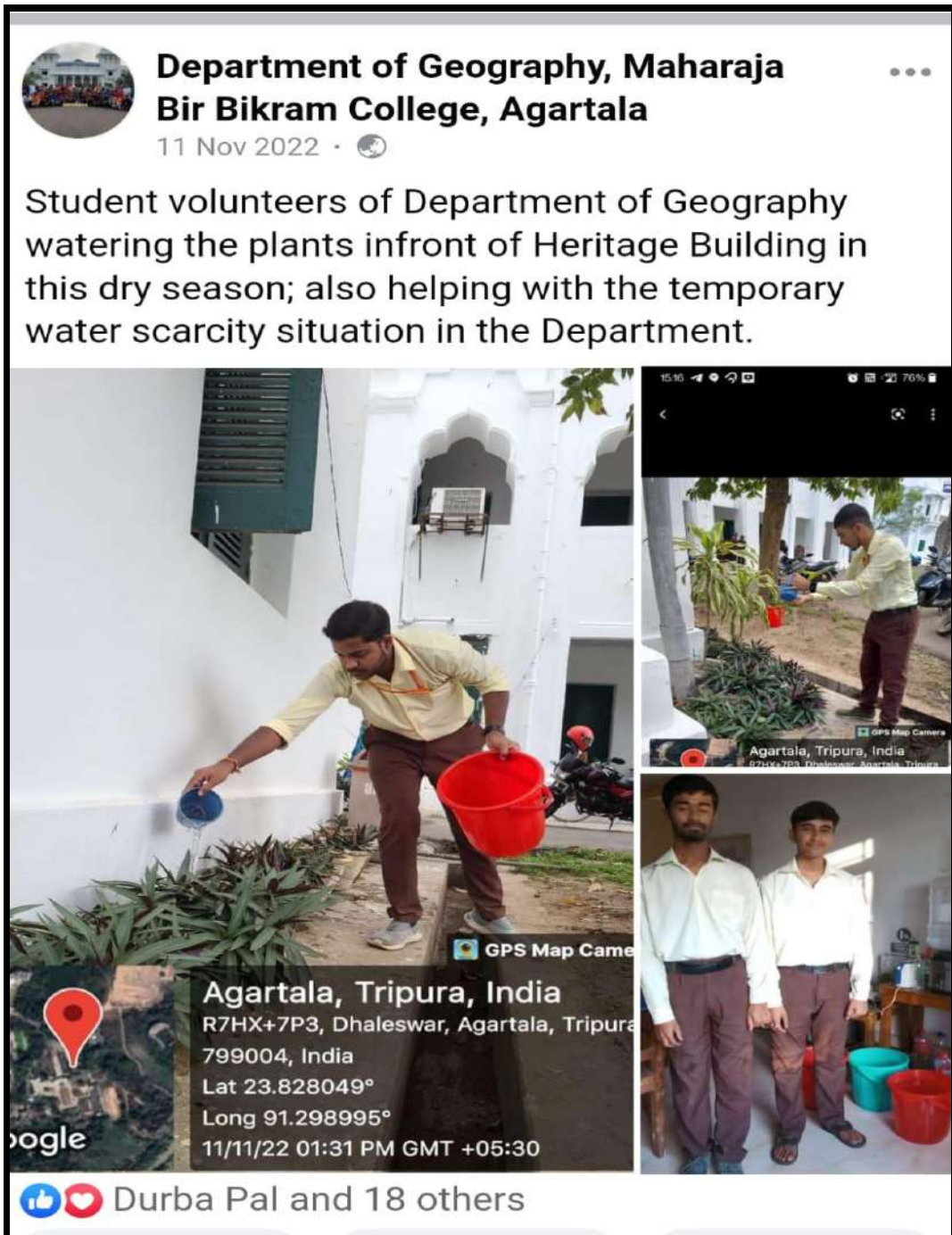

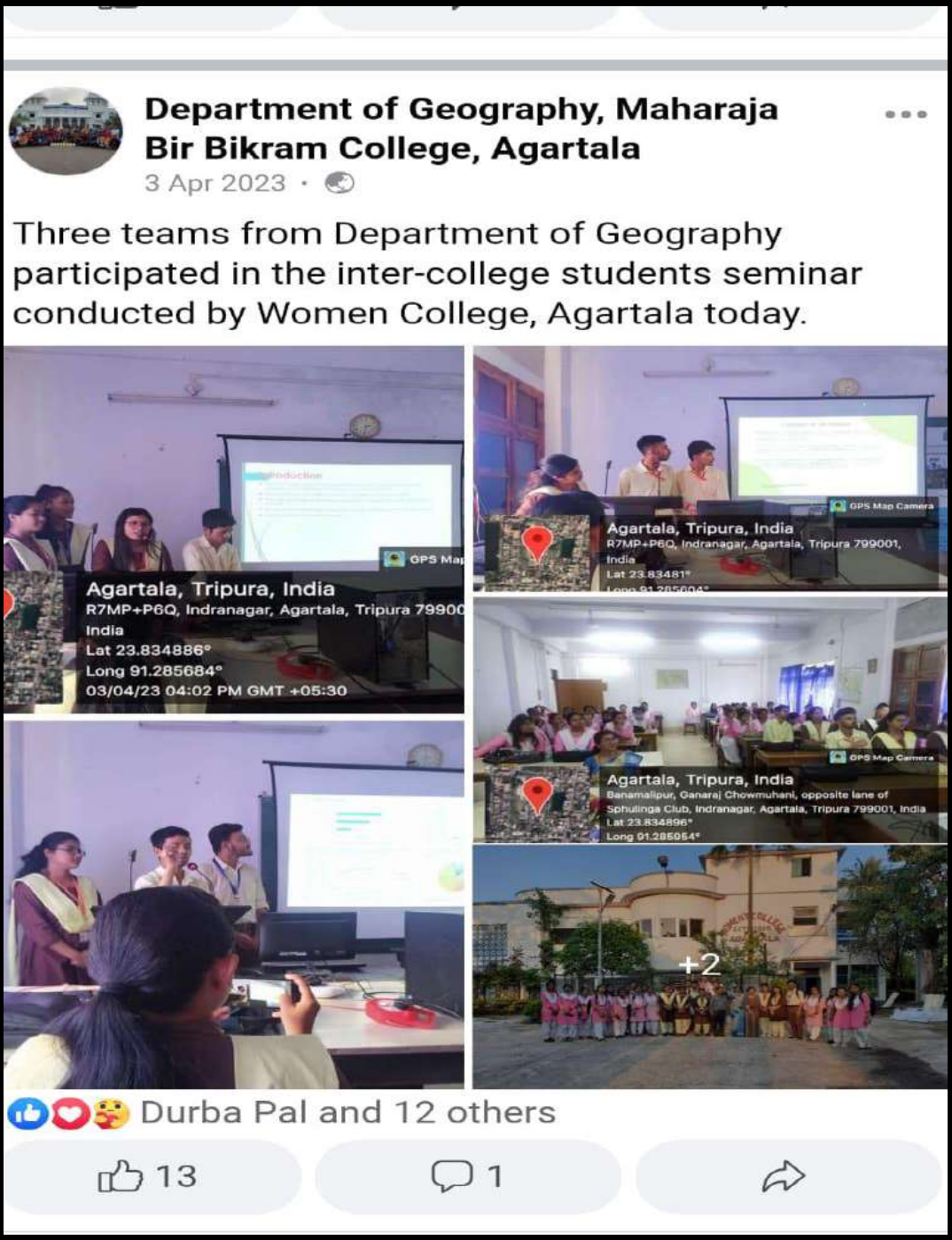


