ANNUAL REPORT OF IQAC (2022-2023)

Academic activities have been performed as per academic calendar (2022-2023). 1723 nos. of students in different six programs (Honours and General) have been admitted out of 1861 sanctioned seats in first semester and total 4319 numbers of students have been admitted in three semesters in this academic session.

Total number of faculty members in that academic session was 75. Induction Programme for Fresher's and continuous academic evaluations were done successfully in this session. No fund allocated under RUSA and NEC during this academic year.

NSS unit of MBBC performed 35 numbers of different activities. NCC unit of MBBC has organized / participated actively in 23 numbers of programmes. Students of our college have been participated in 05 numbers of national and state level sports events. Fifteen numbers of cultural activities were organized by our college.

Four programmes were organized by placement cell of our college for placement opportunities.

Seventeen (17) numbers of seminar/webinar/workshop/ conference/lecture series were organized by the different departments under the guidance of IQAC, MBBC College during the period from 01/09/2022 to 31/08/2023.

Two (02) research projects (which were sanctioned during the academic session 2021-22) are running in the college during this academic session 2022-23, one to the department of Zoology (one year project worth Rs. 1.25 lacks awarded by DBT, Govt. of Tripura) and one to the department of Statistics (awarded by AGMC, Govt. of Tripura). During the academic year 2022-23 another project of Rs. 0.82 lakhs has been awarded to Department of Zoology by the Directorate of Biotechnology, Govt. of Tripura.

In total fifteen (15) nos. of research papers were published by the teachers in different journals including one paper in UGC-CARE list. Eight (08) books / book chapters were published by the teachers. Students of the college participated.

Indigenous management information system (MIS), Process for Internal restructuring of system of accounting (PIRSA) were introduced as best practice.

In this academic year the college has signed three Memorandum of Understanding -


- i) The MoU with the ICFAI University will help in collaboration work between the two institute in academic and research activities.

- iii) The MoU with AIM Foundation, Kolkata will help the institute with regard to Health Matter and also academic exchange programme.
- iv) The MoU with Peerless Hospital and Research Center, Kolkata will help to jointly promote special privileges for all faculty members, students and non-teaching staffs of the college on medical benefit and also at the same time to organized different educational health oriented academic endeavors like seminar, health talks, and awareness programme between the two Institutes.
- v) The MoU with Sachin Deb Barman Memorial Government Music College came to an agreement for cooperative spirits for enhancing the intellectual capabilities of the teaching fraternity and students between the two institutes. At the same time keeping the reach cultural heritage of the state in the field of music is going to promote among the youths the essence of the flavor of ethnic mosaic with enriching music.

As per the need of the students maximum teachers have adopted modern pedagogic styles and ICT in teaching.

As a part of skill development workshop like Mushroom Cultivation and Vermicompost preparation were organized for students by the college.

Grievances cell of the college has received no complaint in any aspect during this academic session.

Academic Audit was completed successfully. Feedback from students, teachers and Alumni were collected, analyzed and action taken accordingly. The college has done all the preparatory work for implementation of NEP-2020 from 2023-2024 academic sessions.
