1. (01/04/2020)

Sanitization Activities :-

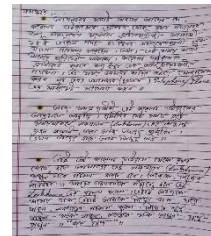
As a part of the various activities to fight against the covid-19 pandemic situation the NCC cadets came forward and sanitized their homes and streets of their own locality.

Research on Water Bodies :-

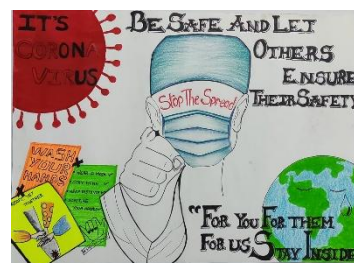

ii. NDRF Registration:-

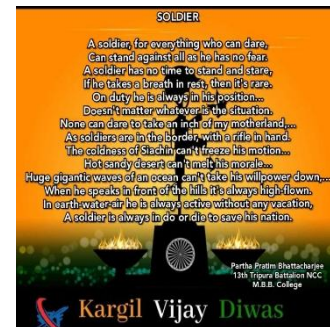

Kargil Vijay Diwas:-

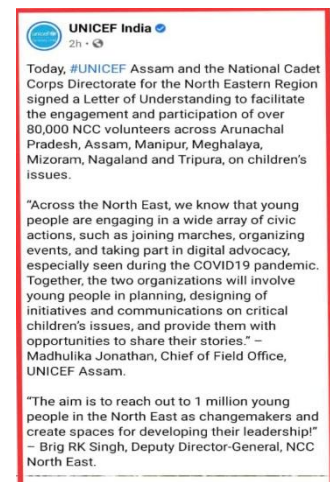
- i. All the cadets participated in online quiz competition on event of the Kargil Vijay Diwas through the Mygov. aap, as well as we got e-certificates.

Essay and Drawing on Swacch Bharat Abhiyan :-

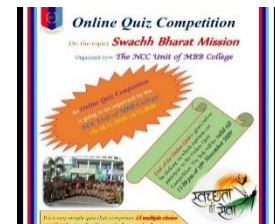
Essay and Drawings were prepared by each and every Cadet of MBB College in flying colors and circulated with the motive of making people aware about the necessity of a clean and healthy environment.

Quiz on Swacch Bharat Abhiyan :-

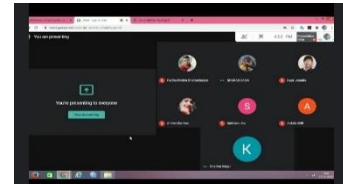
