Students' Code of Conduct

- 8.Students are forbidden from inviting friends from other institutions and outsiders to the College.
- 9. Silence should be maintained in the college library. Loitering and gossiping in the classrooms and corridors are strictly prohibited. Use of abusive words, slangs are strictly prohibited.
- 10. Students should help to keep college premises and classrooms neat and clean and maintain the greenery and biodiversity of the college premises. Everyone must use dustbin for garbage. Use of plastic is prohibited in the college area. Writing on walls, pillars, bathrooms, furniture and unauthorized parking are strictly prohibited.
