## Guidelines for Authors

VIDYAPATTAN: A Journal of Social and Scientific Research (VJSSR) is **an open-access, multidisciplinary, peer-reviewed** journal that encourages contributions from diverse academic fields. Its main aim is to foster the exchange of knowledge and ideas across Science, Arts, and Commerce. Authors are cordially invited to submit full-length paper, original and unpublished research articles, review papers, case studies, and short communications, based on theoretical or experimental works, are solicited for publication. Submission of article implies that the work has not been published elsewhere; except in the form of an abstract, press report or academic thesis, and is not under consideration for publication elsewhere. The bi-annual issues feature peer-reviewed original articles, editorials, commentaries, news, letter to the editor, event announcements, and other relevant content.

## How to submit an article?

The manuscript should be submitted exclusively via the designated email address: [vidyapattan2026@mbbcollege.in](mailto:vidyapattan2026@mbbcollege.in). The corresponding author is required to submit a soft copy of the manuscript in both PDF and Word formats.

**The initial submission of the manuscript is format-free.** The production department will format all accepted articles. However, author(s) must maintain uniformity in citation style within text (main document) and in the reference section according to the journal's guideline.

## Subject areas for Publication

VIDYAPATTAN is a Multidisciplinary, Open Access journal, covering a wide range of disciplines, including Physical Science, Biological Science, Environmental Science, Humanities, Social Sciences, Management & Commerce, and other areas of Science & Technologies. The journal accepts only previously unpublished research articles (original), Conference/ Seminar papers, Case Studies and Review articles must be previously unpublished.

## Frequency of publication

There will be one Volume and Two issues per year

# 1<sup>st</sup> issue: Tentative date of publication is 30<sup>th</sup> June of each year.

# 2<sup>nd</sup> issue: Tentative date of publication is 30<sup>th</sup> December of each year.

Acknowledgement of the receipt of the manuscript with a MS ID will be provided within seven to ten (7 to 10) days of submission. The final Decision (Accepted/ Rejected) will be communicated to the corresponding author within thirty to forty (30 to 40) days from the date of submission.

## Paper Length

**(i) Research Article:** should be within 2500-6000 words; **(ii) Review article:** should be within 8,000-15,000 words.

Word counts include abstract, keywords, Introduction, materials and methods, results and discussions, Conclusion, acknowledgement and conflict of interest. Table, figure (Chart, graph, image etc), equation, formula, & references are excluded from the word count.

**Peer review** To ensure the quality and fairness of journal, all submitted articles will undergo double-blind peer-review process by members of our nationwide reviewers, editorial board and experts.

## Requirements for the Submission

For article submission to VIDYAPATTAN, authors must provide the following three documents:

1. Cover letter
2. Abstract page
3. Manuscript (main document)

**Document I:** Cover Letter

**Document II:** Graphical Abstract (Link to be provided)

Authors may submit the manuscript with either a structured or unstructured abstract of 150–300 words. A structured abstract should cover the following points:

- **Background:** What is known and the study question
- **Objective(s):** The hypothesis or purpose of the study

- **Methods:** Study design and statistical methods
- **Results:** Outcomes and statistical findings
- **Conclusions:** Relevance and importance of the results

The abstract page must include the full name of author(s) (first name, middle name & Surname), complete Affiliation, e-mail address, & ORCID ID for all authors. Authors who do not have an ORCID ID can create one at: <https://orcid.org/register>

The E-mail address of the corresponding author must be clearly mentioned at the bottom abstract page as follows.

(a) For single author manuscript: **Author's E-mail: [xxxxx@gmail.com](mailto:xxxxx@gmail.com)**; (b) For manuscript with two or more authors: **\*Corresponding Author: [nilasishpal@gmail.com](mailto:nilasishpal@gmail.com)**

### **Document-III: Manuscript**

**The manuscript should be organized into the following sections**

1. Title
2. Abstract
3. Key words
4. Introduction **(Review of literature may be included within the introduction section or presented as a separate section following Introduction)**
5. Materials and Methods/Data and Methodology
6. Results and Discussion/Related Section with your manuscript
7. Conclusion
8. Acknowledgements
9. Conflict of Interest
10. Funding statement
11. References

### **Title**

The manuscript title should be as concise as possible, with the first letter of each word capitalized and formatted in bold. Do not include any author details (names or affiliations) on the title page; submit an anonymized file. VIDYAPATTAN follows a double-blind peer-review process, ensuring that both authors and reviewers remain anonymous to each other.

**Abstract:** Abstract should be between **150-300 words, as specified in document II.**

**Keywords:** Provide 4–6 keywords. The first letter of each keyword should be capitalized, and keywords should be separated by semicolons.

Example: Alkene; Diene; Diel's Alder Reaction; Metathesis.

### Manuscript (General instruction)

- **Page Margin:** Left = 1 inch; Right = 1 inch; Top = 1 inch; Bottom = 1 inch.
- **Paper Size:** A4 Layout, Portrait
- **Language:** English (UK)
- **File format:** Microsoft Word
- **Font Face/ Theme font:** Times New Roman
- **Font Size:** 12 (Whole manuscript)
- **Line Space for Text:** 1.5 line space
- **Paragraph:** One Tab; Alignment = Justified

### Introduction

The Introduction should be clear and concise, covering an overview of the current state-of-the-art related to the research area. **A Review of Literature may be included within the introduction section or presented as a separate section following Introduction.** All references should be current/recent and relevant, and easily searchable online (Google).

### Materials and Methods/ Data and Methodology

The Materials and Methods section should present standard protocols that are properly described and cited. This section must include detailed information about the materials used, experimental procedures, types of instruments, sources of chemicals, and relevant experimental details.

For studies involving human or animal subjects, authors must ensure compliance with national, local, and institutional regulations.

Prior approval from relevant authorities—such as ethical committees or review boards—should be obtained and clearly stated in this section, including specific permissions and measures taken to respect privacy. The journal is not responsible for any violations of these guidelines during manuscript processing or after publication.

### Results and Discussion/Related Section with your manuscript

Results should be presented precisely and clearly in context of the aims and objectives of the study. Authors may choose to present the Results and Discussion as separate sections

or combine them, as appropriate. All tables, graphs, and figures must be explained clearly in the text. The discussion should interpret the significance of the results in the broader context of the research.

## Conclusion

The conclusion should concisely summarize the main findings, emphasizing the importance and relevance of the study.

## Acknowledgements

This section should briefly express gratitude to individuals, funding agencies, and institutions that contributed to the research. Keep acknowledgements concise and focused.

## Conflict of interest

Authors must declare any conflicts of interest relevant to the work, including financial and personal relationships that could interfere with the interpretation of the work. If there are no conflicts of interest, include the statement: **'The authors declare that there is no conflict of interest.'**

## Funding statement

A statement clearly mentioning the name of the funding agency and sanction no etc should be included in this section. If no funding assistance was received by the author, please include the statement: **"No funding has been received to conduct this research work"**.

## References in the text/body

Style of References:

- Use American Psychological Association (APA) style for articles in Science, Social Science, and Commerce disciplines.
- Use Modern Language Association (MLA) style for articles in Humanities.
- References should be up to date and DOI should be provided where available.
- Arrange all references alphabetically in the reference section.

**Abbreviations:** Use standard abbreviations consistently throughout the manuscript.

**Table and Figure:** Table and figure must be positioned in the appropriate location of text.

**Image:** All images (including graphs, pictures, maps, charts, paintings, sketches, and diagrams) must be incorporated into the manuscript content. Colour images must have a minimum resolution of 500 dpi, and grayscale or black and white images must be at least 300 dpi. Accepted file formats are jpg, jpeg, and png. Prepare images according to the specified requirements before including them in the text.

**Image Copyright:** If using images not created by the authors, even if the image is available on the internet, the authors must obtain written consent prior to inclusion. The responsibility to secure authorization to use the photos lies with the author, not the publishers. Written permission must be sought before submission of article.
