ICHR Sponsored Two Day National Seminar



The two – day ICHR Sponsored National Seminar on “Revisiting and Reconstructing the History of North East India – with Special Reference to Tripura” was successfully convened on December 19-20, 2025, at Maharaja Bir Bikram College, Agartala by the Department of History. The seminar served as a vibrant intellectual platform to critically re-examine the history of North East India, advocating for a shift from monolithic national narratives towards inclusive, multi-source methodologies.

The event featured 32 paper presentations across four thematic sessions, four plenary lectures, and a special memorial lecture, engaging over 50 scholars from across India. Discussions prominently focused on decolonizing history, integrating tribal perspectives, leveraging oral traditions and archeology, and analyzing gendered and environmental dimensions of the past. The seminar successfully fostered interdisciplinary dialogue, highlighted Tripura’s unique historical trajectory, and underscored the region’s integral role in the broader sub continental narrative. Over two vibrant days, this seminar not only fostered academic engagement but also strengthened our collective commitment to preserving, interrogating, and disseminating the unique historical consciousness of Northeast India and Tripura.
